Tuition and fees

*Registration fee is \$50 for anyone who is not currently enrolled at our center. Siblings of currently enrolled children are entitled to a discounted registration fee of \$20.00.

*Weekly tuition is \$165.00 (and includes all weekly field trip fees). Tuition is due Monday of each week.

*Tuition is due for every week of the summer (to hold your child's space). **We will give you ONE WEEK of vacation during the summer (tuition free and child may not attend during this week).**

*A sibling discount of 15% will be applied to the oldest child's tuition. There is a 10% discount for the third child.

*It pays to tell a friend...if you refer a new family to L&S, we will credit you one week of tuition (after the new family's enrolled for one month).

Paperwork to complete

A registration packet is comprised of an agreement form, a current physical (which can be obtained from your child's school nurse), and an emergency contact form. This paperwork will be sent to you after we receive a deposit for camp.

Other info. to know

You will receive a monthly calendar to help keep you aware of the themes, trips and activities. Please feel free to ask any questions as we go through the summer.

Library Day

We will visit the New Cumberland Public Library twice a week to have a story and activity time. We will participate in their summer reading program – a great way to practice and keep skills learned throughout the school year current!

Sprinkler Day

One day a week the campers will spend their morning cooling off with some sprinkler fun! Remember to bring your swimsuit, towel, shoes (that can get wet) and dry clothes to change into on this day!

Park and Picnic Day

The campers will spend the majority of this morning in the park. Please pack a brown bag lunch (with a drink) for your child on this day, as hot lunches cannot be ordered. Weather permitting, we will play structured ball games, activities, and relays all morning! Then we will set up under the pavilion to eat our lunches.

Hot Lunches, Snacks, and Ice Cream

Daily lunch is at noon. Children can pack lunch or order catered lunches (orders due on Monday for the following week). The catered lunches are provided by Top Shelf Foods and cost \$2.30/day. (Meals are ordered ahead of time, stop in the office for details).

Two snacks are provided daily. Milk is provided with snack and lunch.

Mr. Frosty (the ice cream truck) comes to visit once weekly. A menu will be provided in your registration packet – campers get to order whatever they want! Those who do not purchase Mr. Frosty will be served an ice pop provided by Learning & Sharing.
